Over the last year we have steadily built a team of Business Support Managers, who can be seen out and about in community settings from Post Offices to your local corner shop! Their experience covers everything from construction to hospitality to social care and everything in between. They also speak a range of languages from Arabic, Bengali, Urdu, Spanish, Cantonese, Ghanaian, Punjabi, French and Polish, helping small businesses navigate all the business support available, so that entrepreneurs can focus on what they love: running their business.

We have also been busy building our website, grow.london/local connecting entrepreneurs with relevant support and guidance on business planning, skills, sales and marketing and much more, as well as providing opportunities to connect with like-minded business owners.


